


LAURE PATTERN: SIZE CHART, MATERIALS, AND YARDAGE TABLES

DIMENSIONS OF THE FINISHED SLEEP SACK

(in cm)	doll	6m	12m	24m
A. Length*	33	55	65	74
B. Chest width	21	31	34	37
C. Foot width	29	43	48	52

(in inches)	doll	6m	12m	24m
A. Length*	13	21.5	25.5	29
B. Chest width	8.25	12.25	13.5	14.5
C. Foot width	11.5	16.75	18.5	20.5

*armpit to bottom



MATERIALS

- **Fabrics** (main and lining): This pattern is designed for medium and lightweight fabrics (cotton, gauze, poplin, voile, ...). Avoid heavyweight and synthetic fabrics. Don't forget to pre-wash your fabrics, to prevent them from shrinking after you have finished the sleep sack.
- **Batting**: For sleep sacks, it is generally advised to use a natural rather than synthetic batting, in order to reduce sweating. For a Summer sleep sack, use a very light batting, or none at all.
- **Fusible interfacing**: 4 small pieces to reinforce the button areas.
- **1 hidden zipper**. Length: - 6 months: 20" (50 cm)
- 12 and 24 months: 23" (60 cm)
(Tip: this pattern works with any size of zipper - it all depends on how far you would like to be able to open the sleep sack)
- **2 buttons** of around 3/4" (2 cm) for the straps. I would advise against the use of kam snaps: DIY kam snaps can suddenly detach after some time, and be a choking hazard.
- **Piping**: 1 piece of around 12.5"/32 cm (optional)
- For the **teether**, you'll need a wooden ring (around 7 cm/3" diameter) and fabric scraps. Make sure the ring is made from *untreated* wood (not varnished, oiled, etc!).

YARDAGE

on 55" wide fabric	5/8	1	1 1/8	1 1/4

***Directional print**: a print which has a direction. If you use a non-directional print, you can place the back pattern on the fabric upside down, and do with less fabric for size 24m.
